HS2 UPDATE

A lot has happened on the political front since the last edition of the News but the Oakervee Report regarding the future of HS2 has yet to be published. Speculation about the contents has been rife, fuelled in particular by an alternative report by the Deputy Chair, Lord Berkeley, who is very critical of the project. Media coverage of these alternative views has been extensive which has meant somewhat wider scrutiny of costs etc. than occurred previously. So....we continue to watch this space!

Meanwhile, 'enabling works' have continued apace, including destruction of ancient woodland (which was supposed to be held until a decision had been made). Stoneleigh and Ashow residents have become increasingly aware of preparations – removal of trees and hedges, weekend deliveries of materials required for the construction site off the B4115, and work around the Stoneleigh Road junction with the A46, as well as noticeable works in the surrounding area.

On 7th January 2020 apparently the Prime Minister was pushed to 'pause, reflect and cancel HS2' by both North and South Warwickshire MPs. HS2 has launched a consultation on generic aspects of the design of it. This includes viaducts and piers. The material to be used is concrete and ideally these components will be fabricated off site and then delivered.


