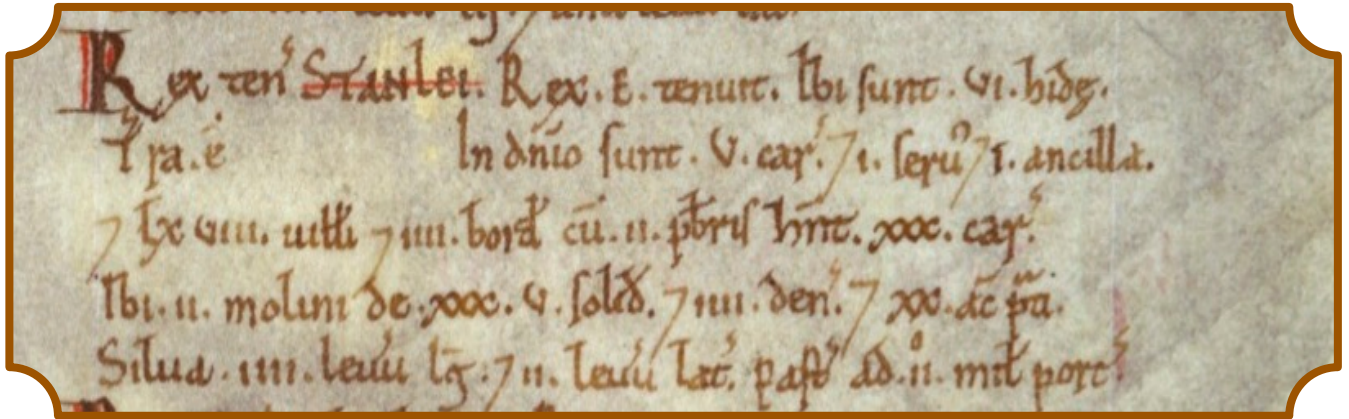


The Domesday Book

Entry for Stoneleigh

1086



The King holds Stanlei.

King Edward held it.

There are 6 hides.

In lordship are 5 ploughs, and 1 male slave and 1 female slave;

and 68 villagers and 4 smallholders with 2 priests

have 30 ploughs.

There are 2 mills rendering 35s 4d.,

and 20 acres of meadow,

woodland 4 leagues long and 2 leagues wide,

pasture for 2,000 pigs.

In all, 27 villages or manors in the Domesday Book were in
The Hundred of Stanlei in Warwickshire.

1 league was about 1½ miles so the Woodland was 18 square miles or 11,520 Acres
